of truck occupants killed in crashes weren't wearing a seat belt.



**Make it click. It could save your life.**

## STAY ALERT



The odds of dying in a rural crash are



than an urban crash - and often involve drowsy driving.



**Feeling sleepy?** Pull over and rest.

*BTW, Loud music, exercise and rolling down the windows don't work.*



## SLOW DOWN

In 2018,

31%

of traffic fatalities were speed related.



**Slow Your Roll:** Big rigs need **40%** more braking distance than passenger vehicles.



## FOCUS ON THE ROAD



of crashes are the result of driver distraction in the 3 seconds before a crash.



**Keep your attention where it belongs:** *on the road.*



## DRIVE CAUTIOUSLY

*Speed limits are for normal road conditions.*



**Reduce your speed by:**

- 1/3 on wet roads
- 1/2 on snowy and icy roads



## DON'T DRIVE IMPAIRED

**“Impaired”** doesn't just mean drunk. It also means high or under the influence of prescription drugs.

- 2 nanograms of active THC means you're impaired
- .04 is the illegal blood alcohol concentration for commercial drivers *(FYI, That's half the illegal limit for passenger drivers)*



**Don't drive impaired – plan ahead and if you plan to be drinking, don't get behind the wheel**



## USE CAUTION IN WORK ZONES

*See cones, get in the zone.*



- Slow down and pay attention in work zones. *You're not the only one working on the highway.*
- See flashing amber or blue lights? *Pull over, it's the law.*
